

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary School Perry Power Plant Emergency Evacuation Plan

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary School presents the following set of guidelines to be implemented should an emergency arise at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

There is a very low probability of a major emergency at the plant, and an even lower one that it would occur during normal school hours. However, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary School does have a comprehensive plan for accomplishing sheltering or evacuation protective action. This plan has been developed in conjunction with the Ashtabula County Emergency Management Agency.

If a Site Area Emergency is declared, children may be held at their schools beyond the normal dismissal time and will await parental pick-up.

If a General Emergency is declared and an evacuation is necessary, students will be safely bused to our receiving school district -- the Ashtabula City School District. Parents/legal guardians will be required to pick up their children at the receiving school building.
