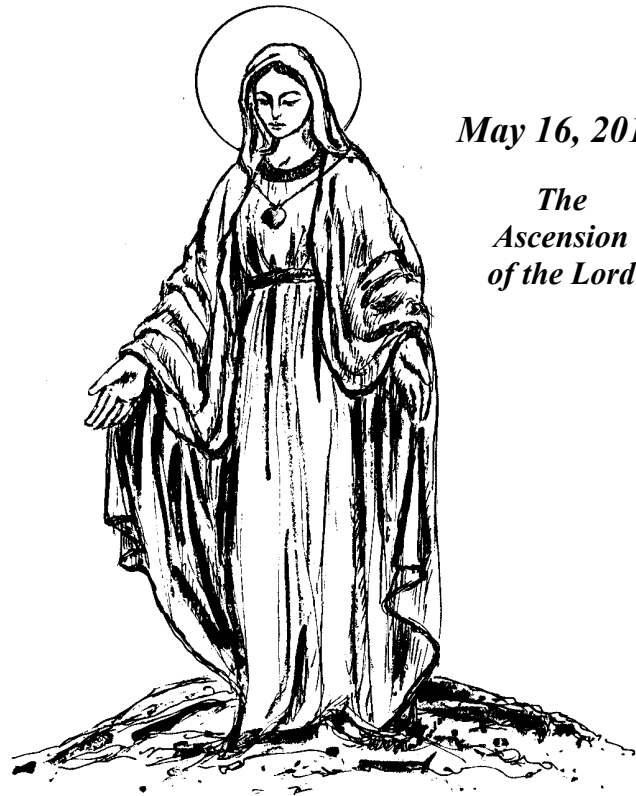

I invite you to a “stakeholder” meeting on Thursday, May 20, 7 pm, in the parish hall to become informed about the needs and changes in the coming school year, 2010-11.

At our last open school meeting March 18, I proposed two “ideas” for the future growth of our school, namely the reopening of the 7th grade and the application to become an International Baccalaureate school for our middle grades (aged 11-16 yrs). Both of these proposals must be withdrawn for now.

The purpose of our meeting on May 20th is to discuss the plan for the best and most affordable Catholic School that will receive support by the majority of the “stakeholders.” At our meeting there will be presented a K through 6 grades with new assignments for some of our teachers. Also, there will be a presentation from our parish/school finance council with regards to the new policy for parishes with schools.
