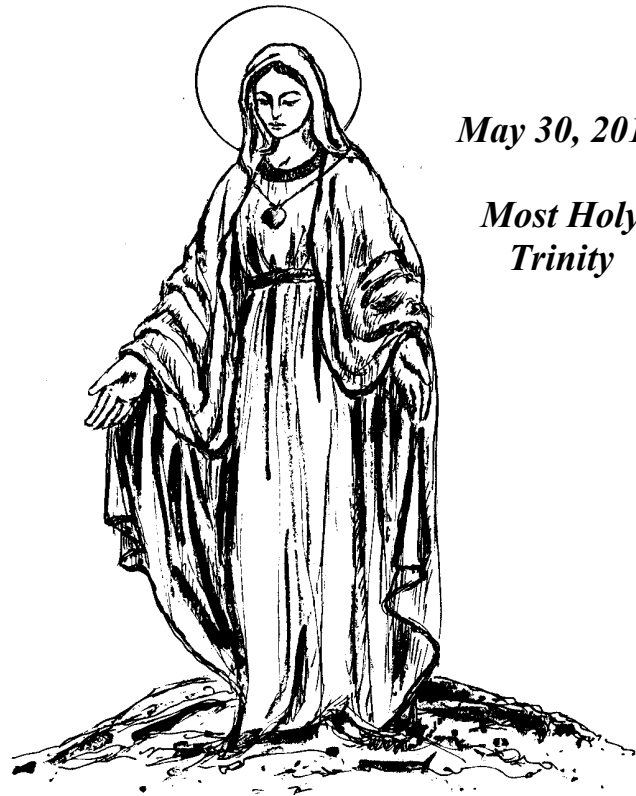

Dear Parents, Faculty, Alumni, Parishioners and Friends of Assumption of the B.V. Mary School (the “Stakeholders”)

Thank you to those who attended the first “stakeholder meeting” that was held on Thursday, May 20. During the first meeting there were several ideas presented on ways to increase the school enrollment and ideas for fundraising.

The purpose of the meeting was to brainstorm ideas and ways to help solve one issue that stands before the school. That issue is that the school and parish MUST submit a balanced budget to the Diocese. In creating the budgets, we have found that the school and parish must find a solution to the deficit before they can present the budget to the Diocese.

Our one goal is that we need to raise \$50,000 for next school year due to the fact that the parish is not able to completely subsidize the school budget, for many reasons.

A second issue is the school needs to continue to market the school all year long and attract new students. Increasing enrollment is the number one way to help the finances of the school.

We need to continue to expand upon the ideas that were presented and create a plan to implement the various solutions. Three committees were formed: recruitment, marketing and fundraising.

Please come to the next meeting to take place on Wednesday, June 2 at 7 pm in the Friendship Room. Please keep the enthusiasm we shared at the last meeting, bring your ideas, and get ready to pitch in and work with a committee.
