CENTRAL AMERICA RELIEF

Catholic Relief Service is assisting Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador. Rains brought by the first tropical storm of the 2010 season, Agatha, pounded Central America, triggering deadly floods and landslides that buried homes, collapsed bridges and destroyed crops. Guatemala lost many lives and forced about 30,000 to take refuge in shelters. Flooding could be worsened by ash from the Pacaya active volcano, 20 miles south of the capital.

In Honduras, floods and mud slides killed 14 and more than 4300 acres of farmland was lost. . Donations can be sent to CRS c/o Office of Social Action, 144 W. Wood St, Youngstown, OH 44503.

RAISING CHRISTIAN HEROES - Fathers Lead

How can we Catholic parents raise children so that they will not only resist evil, but also stand against it with moral courage and spiritual conviction? An Israeli study sought to determine what motivated certain gentiles (non-Jews) to risk their lives to save Jews instead of just standing by or collaborating with the Nazis during the Holocaust. The single most important factor was parenting style— with fathers as leaders in the Faith being one of the crucial four aspects of parenting which helped form the rescuers.
